

Recommended Winter Storage for Solar Charging Systems & Motors



For longest service life: Fully lower lift cradle, remove motor, then store indoors. Remove solar panel & wiring for winter. Winter is harsh on the wires when left exposed. If replacement wiring is needed, check out our website.



If leaving motor on lift, DO NOT cover with a trash bag or plastic. Use the Lift Tech Winter Nylon Cover available on our website. Remove batteries & store inside for longest service life. Charge battery before storing & charge battery before reinstalling back on lift.



Below are recommendations for winter if you choose NOT to store them indoors:

Solar Panels: Recommended a Solar Charge Regulator be integrated to prevent over charging batteries while constantly charging. Batteries: Placing/storing batteries in battery boxes protect the battery from harsh elements allowing batteries to be CONSTANTLY charged. Motors: Lift Tech's Motor Enclosure is recommended for the motor while mounted to the lift, protecting it from the harsh elements and offering a pleasing aesthetic look.
